**Campus Safety Questions:** Answer the questions below substituting appropriate terminology describing violations of law in your home country and in any other country in which you have resided. Include all violations of municipal, local, provincial, state, federal, national, commonwealth, and other governmental jurisdiction’s laws. The term “law” includes codes, legal rules and regulations, and other criminal-type statutes. Your “yes” answer to one or more of the following questions will not necessarily preclude your being admitted. However, your failure to provide complete, accurate, and truthful information will be grounds to deny or withdraw your admission, or to dismiss you after enrollment. For the purpose of the following six questions, “crime” or “criminal charge” refers to any crime other than a traffic-related misdemeanor or an infraction. You must, however, include alcohol or drug offenses whether or not they are traffic related.

- b) Have you entered a plea of guilty, no contest, “*nolo contendere*,” or an Alford plea, or have you received a deferred prosecution or prayer for judgment continued, to a criminal charge?  Yes  No

**If you answered “yes” to any of the six questions above, explain the circumstances on a separate sheet of paper.** Print your full name at the top of the page and sign and date your submission. Furthermore, you must promptly notify the **International Programs Center** in writing of any criminal charge; any disposition of a criminal charge; any school, college, or university disciplinary action against you; or any type of military discharge (other than an honorable discharge) that occurs at any time after you submit this application. Failure to do so will be grounds to deny or withdraw your admission, or to dismiss you after enrollment.

**Application Agreement:** I certify that these responses are true and complete to the best of my knowledge, pursuant to reasonable inquiry where needed, and I am aware that any knowing omissions or falsification herein may result in disciplinary action including denial of admission or dismissal after admission. Further, it is my understanding that I shall not be considered for admission to the University until I have submitted all credentials. I agree to inform the **International Programs Center**, in writing, of any change in my plans to attend the University, any change of address, or any change of plans relating to attending as an on-campus or commuting student. **I understand that if I wish to enroll during a semester other than the semester for which I am admitted, I must contact the Director of International Admissions to defer my application. I understand that if I discontinue my enrollment at UNCG at any time, I must submit a new application by the appropriate deadline.** I also understand that the provision of my Social Security Number and my ethnic/racial origin are not required to be considered for admission to the University.
